TUITION

Students will take part in 17.5 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know London. With 5 half day excursions a week around London as well as a full day excursion, students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest. Includes transport pass around London.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
