TUITION

Students will take part in 22.5 hours of lectures, workshops and project-based lessons that teach professional skills in contexts such as project management, marketing and business management.

The Young Business Leaders is a demanding program, using case studies to focus on entrepreneurship, leadership and effective professional communication. Featuring coaching on presentation skills and effective teamwork, students work towards a final presentation pitch in the final lesson in each 2 week course. The course is held at CATS Academy Boston, a leading high school located on a vibrant campus in the leafy suburb of Braintree. It is located just 10 miles from downtown Boston and 10 miles from the beach! There are common rooms, computer rooms and modern study facilities, as well as WiFi available in all buildings.
